Our first band will be stepping off at 11:00am, following the parade route down Lincoln Ave. past Trinity Lutheran Church and taking a left turn on to Main street.




The awards ceremony will follow the conclusion of the parade and will be held in Central Park.


Dassel Cokato

The Dassel-Cokato Marching Chargers have been competing in the Minnesota parade circuit since Dassel and Cokato combined High Schools in 1972 and is part of a comprehensive music program that includes 2 concert bands, marching band, jazz bands, pit orchestra for musicals, and winter drumline. They have appeared in parades across the United States including: Minnesota, Wisconsin, Michigan, Illinois, Florida, Rhode Island, Massachusetts, Missouri, Colorado, Nevada, and the Dakotas. In the Minnesota circuit, the National Cherry Festival, and the Parade Of Nations Lions Parade the band has received numerous caption awards for Best Colorguard, Drumline, Drum Major, Winds, and top finishes in competition.
